MINUTES

With 13 members and no guests present, Chair Al R. called the meeting to order.

- I. Auction
Mike B. called the auction. The net amount to the Club was \$7.30.
- II. Program
A video from the HVNS library entitled “Introduction to Ancients and Early Armenian Kings” by Leon Saryan was presented.
- III. Show and Tell
Reg N. discussed a Roman denarius and two Parthian coins.
- IV. Recognitions
Al R. circulated a thank you card recognizing the support of Heidi Bey and Edna Green.
- V. Finance, Membership and MSNS Sponsorship
Reg N. reported the Club’s current checkbook balance is \$7,044.55. This amount represents a decline of \$503.89 from last month’s total of \$7,548.44.

Since the Club’s last meeting, two additional memberships have been paid. There are still approximately 20 individuals who paid dues in 2014 but have not yet paid their 2015 dues.

A \$300 donation was made to MSNS to sponsor the first place award for Class 9—Juniors 8 – 12 at their Spring show.

VI. Volunteer Opportunities

Guenther L. reported on the Holy Spirit Business Exposition (2/21 and 2/22, 2015) and the Boy Scout Merit Badge Seminar (3/18/2015). Guenther, Ken G. and Mike H. will represent the Club at Holy Spirit. Guenther and Wayne W. have volunteered for the Boy Scout Seminar. About six more volunteers are needed.

Mike B. is preparing the 3/28/2015 HVNS Coin Show. This will be the Club's 12th Show. A volunteer sign-up sheet will be circulated at our March meeting.

VII. Surveys

Two surveys are in process. Results from the Members' survey are still coming in. A summary will be provided at our March meeting.

A second survey was sent to other coin clubs. Responses have not been forthcoming and the survey will be discontinued.

VIII. Other

Jim M. has authored a tri-fold advertising brochure for the Club in two versions. Examples were circulated for review and comment. Ken G. and Glen R. will check on prices for producing the brochures.

Glen R. reported on his unsatisfactory experience with a national auction firm.

Dave E. discussed new donations to our library and the purchase of a five volume Krause DVD on world coins.

Mike B. suggested the purchase of a small trailer to house our tables, signs, kitchenware, etc. The suggestion will be on the agenda of the next Board meeting.

Jim M. won the attendance prize which was a U.S. silver dollar commemorating the Los Angeles Olympic Games.
