SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

I. Introduction

The object of the Huron Valley Numismatic Society (HVNS) is to encourage and dispense numismatic knowledge to collectors and those interested in becoming collectors and to cultivate fraternity among its members. To that end, HVNS may offer up to two American Numismatic Association (ANA) School of Numismatics Diploma Program scholarships each year. The actual number of scholarships to be offered in a calendar year will be determined by the Board of Directors at its first meeting of the year.

II. The Scholarship

The scholarship provides full reimbursement for the cost of the ANA School of Numismatics Diploma Program.

Upon receipt of proof of registration and purchase of the complete materials package for the ANA Numismatics Diploma Program (currently \$409), HVNS will reimburse the scholarship recipient \$100. And, upon receipt of proof that the scholarship recipient has completed the final examination and been awarded a "Numismatic Scholar" certificate. HVNS will reimburse him/her the remainder of the cost.

III. Application Requirements

A. An applicant must be a member of the ANA and a member in good standing of HVNS.

To be a member in good standing of HVNS, the applicant must have:

1. Been a member of HVNS for at least one year (12 months)
2. Attended 7 of the most recent 12 HVNS meetings
3. Been active in the club, e.g., served as an Officer, Board Member, or appointee; given presentations at club meetings; helped at HVNS coin shows and/or HVNS sponsored events.

B. An applicant must complete an Application Form (available from the club Chair)

IV. Selection

A. Criteria/eligibility for selection include, but are not limited to:

1. Potential to complete the program
2. Past contributions to the club
3. Potential for future contributions to the club

B. The HVNS Board of Directors will determine the eligible applicants, put their names in a hat, and draw names of those to receive scholarships.
