Huron Valley Numismatic Society Librarian Handbook

I. What is the HVNS Library?

The HVNS Library is a lending library that is maintained by the club. It is composed current numismatic books and DVDs that are lent to members at no cost.

II. Who is responsible for the HVNS Library?

The HVNS Constitution gives responsibility for the HVNS Library to the holder of Board Seat 4: Education Chair. However, by practice, a Librarian has been appointed each year by the Chair.

III. What does the HVNS Librarian do?

The HVNS Librarian

- A. In consultation with members, especially the Program Chair, acquires books and DVDs by
 - 1. Buying books and DVDs with money budgeted for the Library by the Board of Directors (The Library budget is set by the Board at its January meeting.)
 - 2. Ordering DVDs from the Central States Numismatic Society (As a CSNS member, HVNS is entitled to receive up to five DVDs each year at no cost.)
 - 3. Accepting donations, e.g., from speakers and members
- B. Puts acquisitions into the HVNS Library by

- 1. Sending the club Web Master the name of the DVD or book, (e.g., *Burger Doubloons*), the author (e.g., William Swoger), the source (e.g., HVNS Purchase), and a digital photo of the cover to post on the Library Page of the Members' Only section of the HVNS web site.
- 2. Storing and maintaining the book or DVD in a place in his/her home that prolongs their life and usability
- 3. Loaning books, upon request, to members for a specified period of time and keeping records of the loans and returns
- 4. Promoting the use of the club Library by, e.g.
 - a. Announcing new acquisitions at meetings and/or by email to members
 - b. Writing reviews of books and DVDs and distributing them at meetings, e.g., on the back of the meeting agendas
 - c. Displaying selected books related to a program at a meeting.
- C. Stores and maintains items accumulated by club Historians that provide information about the club in a place in his/her home that prolongs the life of the items.
- D. Directs the club's participation in the CSNS Library Book Program
 - As a CSNS member, HVNS may purchase and donate \$100 worth of numismatic books/publications to local libraries (public

or school) and	qualify for an	additional:	\$500 fro	om CSNS t	to
purchase more	books for libr	aries each y	ear.
