With 13 members present, Chair Ernie N. called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and introduced the evening's numismatic terms "convex" (an adjective that describes a surface, e.g., of a die or a coin, that curves outward or is thicker in the middle than the edges) and "concave" (an adjective that describes a surface that curves inward or is thinner in the middle than on the edges).
- II. Program Chair Al R. introduced Andrew Kolbert who gave an illustrated and informative introduction to many of the 115 different die varieties of silver dollars minted by the United States from 1794 to 1803.
