MINUTES

- I. Chair Al R. convened the meeting in an April 8, 2020 email to all members. 18 members were in attendance (see II below).
- II. The program was an open book quiz with 25 multiple choice questions titled "Coins, Medals, Tokens and More". Members who sent their answers to the Chair by April 24, 2020 were considered in attendance and eligible for the Attendance Prize drawing.
- III. Members provided status reports:
 - Coin Shows (Chuck S.): Our coin show slated for March 22, 2020 has been postponed until October 17, 2020.
 - Finances and Membership (Keith M.): We have 17 2020 paid Individual Memberships, 7 2020 paid Family Memberships, 0 2020 paid Junior Memberships and 1 Life Membership. We also have \$5,570.46 in our club checking account.
 - National Coin Week (Mark J.): Displays at the Milford Public Library and the Croman Regional Library were canceled, however we are still entering the ANA's Club's Club Trivia Challenge contest.
 - Coin Appraisal Night (Reg N.): Our April 14, 2020 Coin Appraisal Night at Milford Public Library has been postponed to a date to be determined.
- IV. For nearly three weeks, members shared numismatic information, including a PowerPoint presentation created by Glen R. entitled "A Comparative Sample of Small Currency", articles Ernie N. wrote entitled

“Artifacts of Andrew Jackson’s Bank War” and “Civil War Tokens Issued for Brighton, Michigan Merchants”, a half dozen articles on foreign coin errors by Al R, information on PCGS Registry Sets from Mike B. and YouTube videos on chocolate coins, coin vending machines and anodized coin toning.

- V. On April 24, 2020, Al R. provided the answers to the quiz and drew the Attendance Prize winners. Ken G. and Mike B. won Silver Eagle coins.
- VI. On April 26, 2020, Al R. adjourned the meeting.
