MINUTES

- I. Chair Al R. convened the meeting in a May 13 email to all members. Fifteen members were in attendance (see II below).
- II. The program was an open book quiz titled “Currencies and Their Official Country”. Members who sent their answers to the Chair by April 24, 2020 were considered in attendance and eligible for the Attendance Prize drawing (as were member who shared a “My Favorite Coin” story).
- III. Members provided status reports:
 - Finances and Membership (Keith M.): We have 17 2020 paid Individual Memberships, 10 2020 paid Family Memberships, 0 2020 paid Junior Memberships and 1 Life Membership. We also have \$5,640.46 in our club checking account.
 - National Coin Week (Al R.): The winners of the ANA’s Club’s Club Trivia Challenge contest will be announced after June 5, 2020.
 - Club Library (Al R): The Board of Directors voted to discontinue the Club Library and offer the books to members in a Dutch/Silent auction later this year. Details will follow.
 - Numismatic Education (Reg N.): We renewed one-year subscriptions to *Coin World* for Milford Public Library, Cromaine Library and Highland Township Library.

- IV. For two weeks , members shared numismatic information, including “My Favorite Coin” stories by Jim M., Al R., Ernie N., Gary F., Uni M. and Reg N.; numismatic articles, including four by Ernie N. and YouTube links, including an interview with the late Ray Dillard and a lecture on “Why We Collect”.
- V. On May 25, 2020 Al R. provided the answers to the quiz and drew the Attendance Prize winners. Gary F. and Glen G. won Silver Eagle coins to be picked up at the next in-person meeting
- VI. On April 26, 2020, Al R. adjourned the meeting.
