MINUTES

- I. With 14 members and one guest present, Chair Al R. called o order the meetng dedicated to the memory of Dan Freeland.
- II. Program Chair Ernie N. introduced Brett Irick who gave a detailed PowerPoint presentation entitled “A Beginner Set of Mexican Type Coins” that was well illustrated with coins from his impressive collection.
- III. Reports
 - A. Al R. reported for Treasurer Keith M, that we have 35 paid members (including Individual and Family Memberships) and \$4,678.07 in our club checking account at Huron Valley State Bank.

He also noted that the club’s Board of Directors (BOD) met on April 11, did a line-by-line review of the 2021 Budget and determined that revenues and expenses are as projected.
 - B. Al R. reported for Uni M. that our Highland Station Sesquicentennial Commemorative elongated coins project is on schedule and within budget. And, we’re optimistic the elongated coins will be delivered to us by October 2021 to give to members and present to the Highland Township Board of Trustees.

- C. Mark J. reported that our National Coin Week Club Trivia Contest answers are prepared and will be submitted to the American Numismatic Association (ANA) before the deadline.
- D. Al R. reported that the Highland Activity Center (HAC) is being remodeled and is not available to our club for the rest of the year. So, the BOD has decided to resume in-person meetings (with coronavirus safety protocols) in the side-room at Colasanti's Market located at 68 S. Milford Rd. in Highland, MI – ½ mile south of HAC. Chuck S. will workout the details with the owner.

He also reported that the HVNS August meeting will be on Monday August 9 to accommodate members who plan to attend the ANA World's Fair of Money in Chicago, IL August 10 through 14. We're not planning to have a Summer Dinner in July but hope to have our annual Holidays Dinner in December, and we're still planning to have our Library Books Sale and a Members Bourse at 2021 meetings to be determined.

- IV. Coin Shows Director Chuck S. confirmed the Polish American Society (PANS) and HVNS coin show is scheduled for August 29 at the American Polish Cultural Center in Troy, MI. He will also look into the possibility of an HVNS coin show in the fall of 2021. Securing a site and avoiding a conflict with already scheduled shows will be the main factors.
- V. Gary F. and Dave B won Attendance Prizes.
- VI. Attendees shared numismatic information.
